A Phase 2 Report to guide the development of a new strategy for our Natural Resources was released on May 7th. This report has generated recent controversy as the three-person expert panel for forests was divided and submitted two separate reports on forestry management in Nova Scotia.

TIANS supports a new path for sustainable forestry in Nova Scotia. The tourism industry in Nova Scotia generates \$1.8 billion in revenues, provides nearly 40,000 jobs, and contributes \$225 million in federal, provincial and municipal taxes.

The protection of our natural resources is crucial for tourism to continue as a long-term sustainable industry. If you agree, please support your government in making positive change now. This is the first time that a comprehensive forest strategy review has been done in Nova Scotia since the early 1980's. We may not see another opportunity like this for many years to come.
